KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

The Norwood National Bank of Greenville

a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Three Hundred and fifty and 63/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

Henry T. Mills, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and City of Greenville in Ward No. 6 fronting on McDaniel Avenue, and containing six and 961/1000 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit:—Beginning at an iron pin on McDaniel Avenue Two hundred and seventy & 2/3 feet from Cleveland Street South and running thence S. 85 E. Fourteen hundred and fifty-one feet to an iron pin on line of James McDaniel's land; thence with line of James McDaniel S. 3 W. two hundred and nine feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85 W. fourteen hundred and fifty-one feet to an iron pin on McDaniel Avenue; thence with McDaniel Avenue N. 3 E. two hundred and nine feet to the beginning corner and being a part of what is known as the Judson Place.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and... his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and... his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, J.W. Norwood, its President and S.A. Moore, its Cashier on this the 6th day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and in the one hundred and thirty-sixth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.

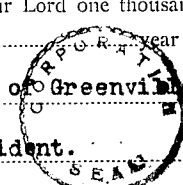
