KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That
The Norwood National Bank of Greenville
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of United States and having its principal place of business at
in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the
sum of Six Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

J.J. McCarter, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the South side of Rhett Street: Beginning at an iron pin one hundred and eleven feet from the East side of O'Neal Street, and running thence S. 19 1/2 E. 183 feet to an iron pin at Celey's corner; thence N. 70 1/2 E. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19 1/2 W. 183 feet to an iron pin on Rhett Street; thence with Rhett Street S. 70 1/2 W. 52 feet to the beginning corner; the above lot is known as lot No. 6 on plat made by J.N. Southern February 2nd. A.D. 1910, and recorded in office of R.M.C., for Greenville County in Plat, Book A, page 377; also being the same lot of land conveyed to W.A. Simpson and W.D. Sitton by James I. West, Trustee duly appointed and qualified, of the estate of John G. Wyatt in bankruptcy, and said deed of conveyance bearing date of execution by the said James I. West, Trustee of March 7th. A.D., 1910. and recorded in office of R.M.C., for Greenville County in Book 3, of deeds, page 287; on the 12th. day of March A.D., 1910. Being the same lot of land conveyed to the Norwood National Bank by W.A. Simpson and W.D. Sitton by deed dated October 3, 1910, and recorded in R.M.C., office for Greenville County Vol. 6 page 203.

For a complete chain of title and for a further description of said lot of land reference is hereby made to the above references and plat.

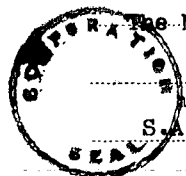
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
