

The Norwood National Bank DEED TO W.G. Trotter

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Norwood National Bank of Greenville

a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-six hundred DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

W.G. Trotter, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid about two and one-half miles from Greenville Court House near the Farmers Oil Mill on the White Horse Road, containing forty-seven acres, more or less, as per plat made by W.A. Hudson and bounded by lands of Davis, T.A. Honour and Estate of Earle and being the same tract of land conveyed to it by J.R. Yown and Camilla Y. Looper by deed bearing date the 18th, day December 1908 and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for said County in Book Y-Y-Y, page 421.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person who may lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, J.W. Norwood, its President and S.A. Moore, its Cashier. on this the 15th, day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and in the one hundred and thirty-sixth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
