KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Norwood National Bank of Greenville

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of United States of America and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand four hundred and fifty-two and no/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

W.P. Conyers, T.C. Gower and Davis Furman, All its right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing thirteen and two-tenths (13-2/10) acres, more or less, being part of the McHugh Tract, and having the following lines, courses and distances, according to plat made by H. Olin Jones, Engineer, Dec. 1912, to wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of other lands of the Grantor herein, being in the line of Thompkins property; thence N. 87.17 E. 1107. feet to an iron pin on line of land belonging to W.A. Chandler; thence along line of other lands of W.A. Chandler, S. 24.33 W. 1170.6 feet to railroad iron; thence along other lands of W.A.-Chandler, N. 31.25 W. 1185.9 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

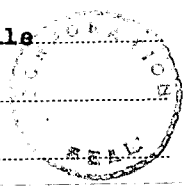
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, on this the 11th, day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twelve, and in the one hundred and 37th. year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
