DEED TO J. G. Campbell.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That it Cleveland & Williams

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand & Fifty (\$1050.00) DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

J. G. Campbell All those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate lying and being near the City limits of Greenville State and County of said being known as Lots No. 8, 9, 10 in Block "b" on the Sub-division known as "Summit View" and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on Redstone Street Corner of Lots 10 & 11 and running thence N. 50-0 W. 150 feet to an alley; thence S. 40-0 W. 150 feet to stake; thence S. 50-0 E. 150 feet to stake on Redstone Street; thence N. 40-0 E. 150 feet to beginning stake on Redstone Street.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, J. Hudson Williams Vice President and Secy on this the 22nd day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven and in the one hundred and 35th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
