KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Thomas M. Walker & Co., Inc.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Six Hundred DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

Mabel M.B. Charles her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate on the south side of Rhett Street in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, being known as lot no. 55, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book E page 146, and described as follows: Beginning on the south side of said street at the corner of lot no. 56, and run thence S. 10.27 E. 91.4 feet to corner of lot no. 54 thence S. 79.44 W. 41 feet; thence N. 9.31 W. 86 feet to Rhett Street thence N. 71.57 E. 40 feet along Rhett Street to the beginning corner.

For value received, so much of the land as is within described is hereby released from the lien of the mortgage to the undersigned by Thomas M. Walker Co.
