KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Thomas M. Walker & Co. Inc.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Four Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mabel M.B. Charles, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate in the city and County of Greenville, South Carolina, on the Southwest side of Hammond Street, Beginning at the corner of lot no. 40, and running thence N. 36.47 W. 52.25 feet along said street to corner of lot no. 42; thence S. 40.21 W. 100 feet to point on 18 foot street; thence S. 36.36 E. 51.54 feet to corner of lot no. 40; thence N. 40.47 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being lot no. 41 as shown on plat recorded in Old Book E page 146.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
