W.P. Rodgers, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Oak-Lawn Township, County of
 Greenville, on the road from Fork Shoals to the Augusta Road, containing seventy acres, more or
 less, as shown by plat made by Wm. F. Lee & surveyed by him Nov. 29 & 30th, 1910 reference
 thereto being had will more fully appear. This tract was cut from the tract of land I bought

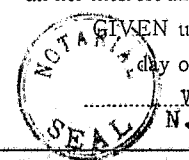
