Hightower, of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A.L. Hightower, All those 2 certain pieces or parcels of land situate, lying & being in the County and State aforesaid in Highland Township and having the following bounds to wit: Track No. 1: Beginning on rock corner near Gin House and running in a southerly direction along branch to John T. Crains line; thence along J.T. Craines line in an westerly to post-oak on T.I. Browns corner; thence along T.I. Browns line in a northeast direction to a rock corner, thence a northerly direction along T.I. Browns line to a rock corner in road leading by E.M. Hightower Residence, then in an easterly direction along said road to beginning rock corner, containing 24 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of T.I. Brown, M.L. Brown, J.T. Crain and others.
