KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John L. Hawkins of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Thirty seven and 50/100 DOLLARS,

to me Pleasant Hill Church (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Pleasant Hill Church a certain lot or parcel of land situated being and lying in Highland
Township and County and State aforesaid, beginning on South east corner of Grave yard running
with said J.L. Hawkins line and plat running South W. about six rods to stone thence N.W. about
fourteen rods to stone at Road, thence with road to Church lot, and lying on South side of Grave
yard bounded on South east and west by J.L. Hawkins, containing 3/4 acres more or less.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Pleasant Hill Church, its
heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Pleasant Hill Church, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
