KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Belle B. Hunt

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Two thousand DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.M. Steele

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.M. Steele, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid near the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being portions of the City View Property and being further described as follows, to wit:-

Lot No. 6 of the plat referred to having the following metes and bounds, to wit:- Beginning at a stake on the Brandon Road sixty feet from Oneal Street at joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6 and running thence with joint lines of said lots in a westernly direction 146 feet to a stake in line of lot No. 4 A: thence with line of said lot 4 A. in a southerly direction 60 feet to a stake at a joint corner of lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence with joint line of said lots 6 and 7 in an Easternly direction 146 feet to a stake in line of Brandon Road; thence with said Brandon Road in a northernly direction 60 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same lot deeded to me by W.T. Henderson and T.F. Hunt, January 9th, 1913, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. Vol. 24, page 35.
