

Eliza Thompson, DEED TO J.J. McSwain

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Eliza Thompson, wife of McBee Thompson, a lawful daughter of Tower Ross by his wife, Rachel Ross. in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.J. McSwain (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.J. McSwain, all my right, title and interest in all the real estate of which my said father Tower Ross, died seized and possessed, and especially in that lot or parcel of land in Ward One in the City of Greenville, said County and State, on the south side of Hampton Avenue, and situate, lying and being between the property of the Hampton Avenue Methodist church and of W.H. Irvine, having a frontage on said Hampton Avenue of about 50 feet, and being all that same lot or parcel of land conveyed to my said father by Stephen King. I hereby represent that I have not sold, or bargained to sell, mortgaged or in any way incumbered my interest in said land; and further represent that I am and have always been recognized as a lawful child of the said Tower Ross; and that I am about fifty years old; and this conveyance is intended to be a full and complete conveyance of all my said interest as heir at law of the said Tower Ross, and of his said wife, Rachel Ross.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.J. McSwain, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.J. McSwain, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
