

H. P. Haley DEED TO Amanda Belue
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H. P. Haley of the City and County of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred (\$700.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Amanda Belue, of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Amanda Belue, and her heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County and Township of Greenville, about one and one-half (1-1/2) miles north of the County Court House, and near the American Spinning Company's Mill, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit:- Beginning at a stake on a ten (10) foot Alley (sometimes called Mill Street) and running thence about N. 21-1/2 E. 120 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Pinckney Street N. 68-1/2 W. 44 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Southern Railway Company, S. 38-1/2 W. 129 feet to a stake on the above mentioned Alley; thence along said ten (10) foot Alley S. 68-1/2 E. 92 feet to the beginning corner, and being a part of Lots No. 15 and 16 on a plat made by W. A. Hudson, D.S. of the Hammett Land, bearing date May 14th, 1900. Said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County and State in Deed Book "H.H.H", at page 835; this being a portion of the land conveyed to us, the said J.C. and H.P. Haley by J.S. Knight, by a deed bearing date 12th, day of November 1904, and recorded in the R.M.C. office of said County and State in deed book "RRR", at page 129. See also Deed Book Volume "V.V.V", at page 512.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Amanda Belue, and her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Amanda Belue, and her

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
