KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Alfred G. Taylor, individually and by virtue of authority conferred upon me as executor of the will of Alfred Taylor, deceased, by will in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and thirty DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.W. Bridwell (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.W. Bridwell, all that piece or lot of land situated, lying and being in said State and County, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Taylors, on a new Street running from the proposed site of the Greenville, Spartanburg and Anderson Railway, for about 103-1/2 feet and facing an other street for 150 feet and known as lots numbers two and three as shown by plat of W.A. Adams, dated April 22nd, 1913. The above plat is recorded in Plat Book C. page 74.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.W. Bridwell, his heirs and assigns, forever.

I, individually and as executor

AND do hereby bind myself, his and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.W. Bridwell, his

heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
