J. H. Surrine DEED TO City of Greenville

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. H. Surrine, of the City and County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the City of Greenville, a municipal corporation duly chartered under the laws of said State, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

City of Greenville, and its successors and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or strip of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the Second Ward of the City of Greenville, on the west side of Brown Street, between Oak and Elford Streets, having a length along said Brown Street of eighty-eight (88) feet, more or less, and being approximately two and one-half (2-1/2) feet wide at the south end thereof and approximately three and one-half (3-1/2) feet wide at the north end thereof, bounded on the east by Brown Street, on the North by lot of John M. Geer, on the south by lot of Greenville Hotel Company, and on the west by other lands belonging to me, the said J.H.Surrine ; the intention of this deed being that the said Brown Street shall be forty (40) feet in total width or thirty (30) feet between the curb stones; all being substantially as shown on a map of Brown Street made by the City Engineer of said City, bearing date February 28, 1913.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said City of Greenville and its successors heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said City of Greenville and its successors

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
