KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Elwell, - D.G., - J.C., - Ella, - and Lucy Rosemond, Essie Wells and Nancy Birten, heirs of Millie Rosemond, late of Greenville County in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other considerations DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.H. Rosemond

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.H. Rosemond, all that piece, or parcel of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the Easley Bridge Road, about three miles from the City of Greenville and being a part of the lands of the late Millie Rosemond, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin on the above Road, cor. Lot No. 1, and running with line of said lot, S. 80 W. 8.10 chains to a stake, thence with lines of lots No. 3 and No. 4, S. 43 E. 9.20 chains to the Easley Bridge Road, thence with said Road, 8.50 chains to the beginning cor. containing three and one-half (3-1/2) acres, more or less and shown as lot No. 2 on plat made by F.G. - Rogers, Feb. 1912.
