KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.M. Norwood

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Six hundred DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Woodside Cotton Mills, a corporation (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Woodside Cotton Mills, a corporation, its successors and assigns, all that lot and parcel of land just outside of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known as lots Nos. 8 and 9 in plat of land of W.M. Norwood, known as Norwood Heights, and made by J.N. Southern, Surveyor, recorded in Plat Book A. page 133. Said lots having a frontage on Vance Street of fifty feet each and a depth of one hundred and fifty feet from Vance Street to land of the Woodside Cotton Mills.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Woodside Cotton Mills, its successors, heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Woodside Cotton Mills, its successors

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
