KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. J. Vaughn, of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred and twenty-five DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

A. G. New (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A. G. New: All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, about two miles from the City of Greenville, on the Road leading through the American Spinning Company's Village toward Parris Mountain and containing two acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the said Public Road, corner of D. Bayne's land; thence with said road N. 7 1/4 E. 2.70 to stake in road; thence N. 57 1/2 W. 8.15 to centre of branch; thence S. 30 1/2 W. 2.50 to iron pin, corner of D. Bayne's land; thence with his line S. 57 1/2 E. 9.05 to the beginning corner, according to Plat made by W.A. Hudson, D.S. on January 14th, 1905 and recorded in the R.M.C. office, in Vol. 0.0.0., at page 81, and being the same land this day conveyed to me, by J.M. Gosnell.

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
