J. G. Glasgow (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. G. Glasgow all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Albert Street and run thence N. 80-30 E. 109.5 feet to a pin; thence N. 12-48 W. 60 feet, thence S. 80-30 W. to said Albert Street; thence S. 9-30 E. 60 feet to the Beginning Corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

J. G. Glasgow, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

J. G. Glasgow, his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
