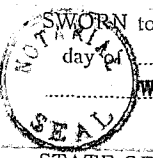

L.K. Kelley, his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, just outside the corporate limits of
the City of Greenville, on the South side of the road leading from the bridge over the Southern
Railway track and the west side of the road running at nearly right angles with the said first
mentioned road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING in the corner
