 in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty-five DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Mrs. Sallie C. Beattie (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mrs. Sallie C. Beattie, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County and State aforesaid, on Middle Saluda River and being the same tract conveyed to me by J.L. and G.M. Bates on June 29, 1898. See Deed recorded in Vol. F.F.F. page 75. Said lot or parcel of land contains between 7 and 8 acres. Because of a change in the bed of the River there is a difference of opinion as to the courses and distances. The land purchased by me from Bates, as above referred to was in two lots or pieces and the description thereof by metes and bounds, courses and distances are fully set out in the deed above referred to, reference to which is hereby craved. A later plat sets forth the description as follows:
 Beginning at a stake on the west bank of Saluda River, nearly opposite the mouth of Wolfe's Creek, and running thence N. 72 W. 5.00 to a stake; thence S. 37-1/4 W. 3.44 to a stake; thence S. 9-3/4 E. 3.72 to a stake thence S. 30-3/4 W. 4.50 to a stake; thence S. 14-1/4 E. 7-85 to a stake on the West bank of the River; thence up the said River to the beginning corner. Bates by the deed above referred to, which is all the land I own in that locality on the West side of the River.
