Meadors, Robt-Bryson, and to construct and maintain in, upon, along and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires, conduits and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line or lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity aforesaid, and also to construct and maintain in, along and through the said premises with poles, wires, etc., a telephone line or lines, together with the right, at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

In case any damage is done to crops in constructing said line, the Enoree Power Co. will pay same provided written claim is made with said Power Co. within 30 days after such damage.

To Have And To Hold, all and singular, the rights, privileges and easements as aforesaid in, to and upon said premises, unto the said Enoree Power Company, its successors and assigns.
