For the sole purpose of establishing and maintaining a line of sewerage in over and through the above named premises for the City of Greenville. The property owner reserving the right to use, occupy, build and enjoy the use of said strip of land in a way not to interfere with the said sewer as it shall be established.

Scarborough of the City and County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, in the consideration of the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) to me in hand paid by the City of Greenville, at and before the sealing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way in, over and through that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situated on or near Nichols Street in the City and County of Greenville and the State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at man-hole in Nichols Street 204' east from manhole in Greene Ave. and running S. 29° 30' West 21 feet to property line, thence continuing S. 29° 30' W. 161 feet to property line of A.C. Davis.

Said right-of-way to be eight feet wide. For the purpose of establishing, constructing or maintaining a sewerage line over and through the said premises for the City of Greenville, the said A.M.
