Whereas, Sarah N. Key, George A. Norwood, Lula N. Mullins, Clara N. Watson, Samuel W. Norwood, Joseph Norwood and Annie N. Moss did by deed bearing date the 11th day of December, 1909 convey to me, J.W. Norwood all their undivided seven eighths interest in certain lands including the lot of land hereinafter described, in trust among other things to sell and convey by fee-simple deed all their said interest in certain of the lands so conveyed including the lot of land hereinafter described; and whereas, I own in my individual right an undivided one-eighth interest in the said lot of land; and whereas, I have as such Trustee and in my individual right sold to J.T. Fonville the lot of land hereinafter described for the sum of Six hundred dollars, Now therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the said J.W. Norwood, as such Trustee and in my individual right, in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, as such Trustee and individually by the said J.T. Fonville, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.T. Fonville, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Ward One, City of Greenville, on North side of Nowood Avenue, having a frontage of sixty (60) feet, more or less, on said Avenue and running back on parallel lines one hundred and fifty (150) -

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feet to the back line, which is of the same length as and parallel to the front line, and being known as Lot No. 13 on a plat of the estate of G.A. Norwood, deceased, made by W.A. Hudson, D.S., on July 8th, 1908, bounded by lots now or formerly owned by Ellen J. and C.G. Gilmer, J.J. Cowart, and others. An undivided seven-eighths interest in said lot of land is hereby conveyed by me as such Trustee under said deed of trust, and an undivided one-eighth interest therein is hereby conveyed by me in my individual right.

Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.T. Fonville, his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind said persons who have executed and delivered to me said deed in trust as aforesaid, their heirs, Executors and Administrators, in so far as I have the right to bind them under the provisions of said trust deed, to warrant and forever defend all and singular an undivided seven-eighths interest in the said premises, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular an undivided one-eighth interest in said premises, unto the said J.T. Fonville, his heirs and assigns against said persons who have executed and delivered to me said deed of trust as aforesaid and their heirs and assigns, (except the said J.T. Fonville and his heirs and assigns) and against myself and my heirs and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, except the said J.T. Fonville, his heirs and assigns.
