KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E. Agnew Webster of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of one and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Mrs. Annie C. Webster, of the same place (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Annie C. Webster, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing two and one-half (2-1/2) acres, more or less, according to a plat by W.D. Neves, dated July 6, 1912, known as Lot No. 3 on said plat, and having the following lines: beginning at an iron pin (north corner of lot No. 2) thence along lot No. 2, S. 45° 20' W. two hundred and seventy-four (274) feet to iron pin; thence N. 42 W. four hundred and sixty five (465) feet to iron pin; thence N. 51° 30' E. two hundred and forty-two (242) feet to iron pin; thence S. 46° 30' E. four hundred and twenty-nine (429) feet to beginning corner.

This is the same land conveyed to me by said Annie C. Webster, July 12, 1912, and this is a re-conveyance of same to her. 19/106.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
