in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of One hundred DOLLARS,
to him in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John Fisher
is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

John Fisher, his child's part, one seventh interest in the following tract of land, known as the
William Durham Home Tract and bounded as follows, Beginning at a red-oak then S. 60 East 18
chains to a stone, then South 35 chains to a stone, then N. 61 West 50 chains to a stake, then
N. 20 West 23 chains to a stake, then S. 86 East 35 chains to the beginning, containing 134
acres, more or less.

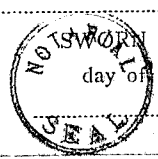

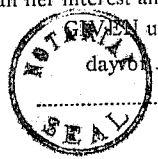
