in consideration of the sum of Five DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by and the further consideration of my
natural love and affection for my wife, Mary B. Wright, (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mary B. Wright, her heirs and assigns, all of my right, title, interest and estate whether
vested, contingent, in remainder or for life, and whether legal or equitable, of, in and to
all of the real estate and personal property bequeathed and devised by my mother, N.A. Wright,
of and by virtue of her last will and testament, and the title to all of such interest, as
aforesaid, I hereby convey unto my said wife wheresoever said property may be situate, whether
in this or other States, and in whatsoever manner it is held by the estate of my said mother,
or by me, as legatee or devised under said last will and testament.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
Mary B. Wright, her heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Mary B. Wright, her

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
