in consideration of the sum of Three thousand no/100 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John L. Stone

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
John L. Stone, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in County and
State aforesaid, and Oaklawn Township, containing fifty and one-half (50-1/2) acres, more or less
and bounded by lands of H.T. Eskew, S.V. Chandler, W.R. Pearson, S.N. Campbell, being same
tract of land conveyed to me by John R. Ridgeway on Nov. 29th, 1909 and recorded in Vol. 5,
page 260 in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
John L. Stone, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said John L. Stone, & his
heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
