

Riley J. Rowley DEED TO L. P. Hillhouse

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Riley J. Rowley, of the State and County aforesaid in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.) Dollars and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. P. Hillhouse (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

L. P. Hillhouse, an undivided one-half interest in all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Westfield Street, in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on Westfield Street, corner of lot now owned by W. B. Anthony thence with the line of his lot N. 67 1/2 W. Two hundred and eighty (280) feet to an alley; thence with said alley S-18-1/2 W. one hundred and five feet and eight inches (105 ft. 8 in.) more or less to corner of lot of Central Graded School; thence with the line of said Graded School lot S. 67 1/2 E. Two hundred and eighty (280) feet to said Westfield Street; thence with said Westfield Street N 18 1/2 E. One hundred and six feet and eight inches (106 ft. 8 in.) more or less, to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to L. P. Hillhouse February 7th, 1914 by J. O. Westfield.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said L. P. Hillhouse his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said L. P. Hillhouse his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
