(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said John H. Earle, his heirs and assigns forever. All my undivided one-half interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on Seach Street -- being known as lot No. 4 in block "B" as shown on a plat of the land of the Melville Land Company said plat being recorded in R. M. C. office in and for Greenville County Plat Book "A" at page 99; said being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Seach Street, 247 ft. from the south-west corner of Garlington St. (being the south east corner of lot No. 3), thence with Seach St. S. 17° 30' W. 52 ft. to an iron pin (N. E. corner of lot No. 5); thence with northline of lot No. 5 N. 75° 30' W. 192 feet to a stake in line of a 20ft. Alley, thence N. 17° 30' E. 52 ft. to an iron pin in line of lot No. 3, and thence with line of last mentioned lot, S. 15° 30' E. 192 ft. to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land sold to Eddie D. Roberson on October 20, 1910 to Melville Land Company, and recorded in Vol. xxx, at page 163 and being the same lot of land conveyed to W. A.
