in consideration of the sum of One hundred and forty-seven & 50/100 DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.L. Cannon

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.L. Cannon, All that certain parcel and lot of land situate and lying in South Carolina, in Greenville County, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Greer, on the North side of Maude Street, Beginning at a stake, corner of lot No. 1, and runs thence N. 12-58 W. one hundred forty two and five tenths (142.5) feet to a stake on Ally; thence with said Ally S. 76-13 W. sixty feet (60) to a stake corner of lot No. 3 and thence S. 12-58 E. one hundred forty two and one half (142.5) feet to stake on Maude Street; thence N. 76-09 E. sixty feet to the beginning corner, being designated as lot No. 2 on a plat prepared by W.N. Willis, Nov. 21st, 1912, and the above premises carries with it the right of easement over and on a twelve foot ally on North end of same which is to remain open, and further, the parties herto agree and it is a part hereof that this property is not be conveyed, or rented to or occupied by a person of African Descent, and this is a covenant to run with the said premises.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

J.L. Cannon, his

heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and

forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.L. Cannon, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
