KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That E.A. Westmoreland,

in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

L.G. Green

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

L.G. Green all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in the Town of Greer, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Emma Street, Brockman's corner and runs thence with Brockman's line 209 feet to Westmoreland's line; thence with Westmoreland's line 92 feet to Mrs. Tanner's line; thence with Mrs. Tanner's line 211 feet to Emma Street; thence along Emma Street 80 feet to the beginning corner..

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said L.G. Green, his heirs and assigns forever.
