

J.W. Norwood DEED TO W.M. Jordan

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.W. Norwood,

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Sixteen thousand and two hundred (\$16,200.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.M. Jordan

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W.M. Jordan, All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid on the west side of Richardson Street in the City of Greenville, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Richardson Street at a point forty (40) feet south of the southwestern corner of the intersection of Washington and Richardson Streets, corner of the lot of the Washington Street Hotel Company; and running thence with the line of said Washington Street Hotel Company eighty-three (83) feet to an iron pin; thence in a southerly direction parallel with the west side of Richardson Street fifty-four (54) feet to an iron pin; thence in an easterly direction parallel with the line of Washington Street Hotel Company eighty-three (83) feet to an iron pin on the west side of Richardson Street; thence in a northerly direction with Richardson Street fifty-four (54) feet to the beginning corner, and being part of a lot of land conveyed to me by James McPherson and others by their deed dated February 25th, 1913, said deed to be recorded.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W.M. Jordan, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.M. Jordan, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
