STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, N. P. Haley, of Greenville County, aged ... in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) DOLLARS, to Me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. Haley

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. C. Haley and his heirs and assigns forever; All that certain piece of parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and county and Township of Greenville, about one and five-eighths (1 5/8) miles north of the County Court House, and near the American Spinning Company's Mills having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stake on a ten foot alley (sometimes called Milk Street) and returning thence about N. 2 1/2 E. 120 feet to a stake thence parallel with Quakhey Street N. 68 1/2 W. 4 1/2 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Southern Railway Company B. 38 1/2 W. 129 feet to a stake on the above mentioned alley; thence along said ten foot alley S. 68 1/2 E. 92 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Amanda Belue by a deed bearing date 20th day of November, 1913 and not yet recorded.

J. C. Haley and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

J. C. Haley and his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof
