KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Markley Realty Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen thousand, four hundred fifty <sup>no</sup>/<sub>100</sub> DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

Co-operative Investment Company, a corporation of South Carolina, having its principal place of business at Greenville in said State, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, beginning at an iron pin in the middle of Jackson Street and running thence S. 20-51 W. 77.56 feet to an iron pin in the middle of the right of way of the Charleston and Western Carolina Railway Company's sidetrack, thence up with the middle of said sidetrack, starting in the direction S. 31-47 E., but following a 14 degree curve, 10.50 feet to a point in the middle of said sidetrack; thence S. 32-31 E., 100 feet to a point in the middle of said sidetrack; thence N. 57-24 E., 48.04 feet to an iron pin at the corner of an open court; thence with the line of the court S. 66-34 E., 89.92 feet to the southwest corner of the building known as the blacksmith shop; thence N. 19-44 E., 98.78 feet to a point on an alley (new line); thence with the line of said alley N. 67-14 W., 205.86 feet to the beginning corner, known as lot no. 12 on the plat of Markley Realty Company made by J. C. Surrine, dated March 26, 1914, and marked N. B. 26.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and its successors heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and its successors heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
