Samuel M. Gowen, all that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, on the south side of East North St, in the city and county of Greenville, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin, 101' 6" from the corner of Jay St, and being the corner of lot #2 as shown on plat Book "A", page 90, of R. U. C. County of Greenville, and running thence with the line of said lot #2 S. 15° E. 185' 0" to a fifteen foot alley, thence along said alley N. 76° - 45' E. 50' 0" to the corner of lot #3, thence along the line of said lot #3 N. 15° W. 185' 0" to the corner of North St, thence along North St, S. 76° - 45' W. 50' 0" to the beginning corner, this being the same lot conveyed to W.
