KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Riverside Land Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

Olive W. Peace all that lot of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, in the fourth part of the City of Greenville, fronting on Webster Street, adjoining lots of William Wood, Mrs. Maud L. Gilbreath and Mrs. W. C. Davis, having the following meter and lines to wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Webster Street and now owned (being 21 1/2 feet from the corner of Fall and Webster Streets) thence with Wood's line northward about 70 feet to stake on Mrs. Maud L. Gilbreath's line, thence with her line eastward 9 1/2 feet to a stake corner of lot now owned by Mrs. W. C. Davis, thence with line of said Davis lot southward about 71 feet to a stake on Webster Street, thence Westward with Webster Street 9 3/2 feet to the beginning. Being the same lot of land conveyed to Riverside Land Company by N. J. Haynesworth and J. A. Russell

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and her heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and her heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
