DEED TO Mrs. S. T. Marshall

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That... The City of Greenville SC

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and 20/100 (\$300.00) DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Mrs. S. T. Marshall, all that certain piece of land or  
lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina  
near Bursonic Street, the boundaries being 20 and 21 of land  
of J. A. Traylor as shown on plat made by J. N. Southern  
D.S. May 23rd, 1901 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville  
County in Book 74 N 1/4 page 833 and bounded as follows:  
Beginning at corner of M. O. Landrum's land at a point on a 20  
foot alley and running thence along said M. O. Landrum's  
line S. 57° 0' 19.65 feet to a corner in a bury, thence S. 34 E. 106  
feet, thence N. 57° 14' E. 196.5 feet to a corner on said alley;  
thence along alley N. 34 W. 106 feet to the beginning and  
again the same lot conveyed to the said City of Greenville  
by J. E. Siegle by deed dated December 6th, 1904, and  
recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol.  
N N W, at page 375.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and

her heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, C. S. Webb as Mayor and G. Frank League as City Clerk & Treasurer  
on this the Twenty-first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine  
hundred and Seventeen, and in the one hundred and Forty-first year of the  
Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
