a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto D. J. Moody

all that certain piece of land, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid near the City of Greenville, this being lot number four (4), sub-division known as Monaghan Annex, part of which is recorded in Plat Book C, office of Register of Deeds Conveyance, Greenville County. 1913

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

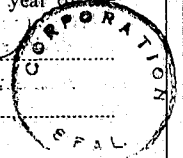
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Marchant, Vice President on this the third day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and in the one hundred and forty-first year of the
