KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Hayler Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other considerations DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Olive A. Peace, all that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lot # 25 of the "Oakland Hill" being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the corner of Mt. Zion Avenue and Church Street and running thence with said Church Street S. 51 N. 67 feet thence to bend in said Street, thence still with said Street S. 29 N. 53 feet thence S. 48-19 N. 70 feet, thence N. 12 1/2 E. 155 feet to corner of lot 24, thence with line of said lot S. 8 1/2 E. 108 feet thence to the beginning corner being the same lot of land conveyed by A. W. Trotter to O. B. Hayler by deed dated May 1, 1912, and recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County Vol. 19 page 241 and conveyed by deed of O. B. Hayler to the Hayler Company.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

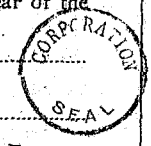
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns forever.
