KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

The Hayles Company  
 a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville, S.C. in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

William G. Sirene will take a certain lot of land situated on the North side of West Stone Avenue, in the first ward of the city of Greenville in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina more particularly described as follows: - Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of West Stone Avenue 187 1/2 feet from the northeast corner of said West Stone Avenue and Townes Street; thence with Stone Avenue S. 84° E. 62 1/2 feet to stone; thence N. 5° E. 200 feet to stake; thence N. 84° 21' 1/2 feet to stake; thence S. 5° W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, being the eastern portion of the lot conveyed by H. D. Carrish and T. C. Cowen to W. O. Hobbs by deed recorded Vol. 38, at page 546, and being the same lot conveyed to grantor by Olive H. Pease by deed recorded in Vol. 44 at page 75 subject however to a mortgage given by W. O. Hobbs to Georgia G. Miller, to secure the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) dated January 28, 1916 and recorded in Volume 53, Page 158 which mortgage is hereby assumed by the grantee as a part of the considerations for this deed, and is subject also to the unpaid portion of the paving assessment which is assumed by the grantee.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, on this the twentieth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, and in the one hundred and forty-first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
