KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

in consideration of the sum of ~~Twenty-two hundred and twenty-two (\$222,00)~~ DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.W. Picklesimer

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.W. Picklesimer: All that certain tract of land situate in said County and State aforesaid: Beginning on the south side of Hooper's Creek and running thence S. 20° E. 9.30 to a piney tree 34 m. from the road; thence S. 73° 46' 6.25 E. back 34 m. near the road; thence S. 74° E. 12.50 to a cornwood 34 m.; thence N. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 21.65 to a sourwood 34 m.; thence N. 44° E. 17.75 to a ash; thence N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 16.66 to a stake 34 m. on branch; thence N. 80° W. 18.7 along the branch to a dogwood 34 m.; thence along the branch N. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.95 m. thence along the branch N. 48° W. 2.75 to a rock 34 m. on Hooper's beginning corner containing forty and fourteenth (40.4) acres, more or less, less one-half acre conveyed away since that time by his widow, and being known as the "house place" or tract #17 the Thomas J. Farr Grade and being the same tract of land which was conveyed to me by J.W. Gray master, by deed on January 4, 1912 and recorded in the R. M. S. office in and for said county and state, in Vol. 14 at page 291.
