KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Jos. A. McCullough in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand - DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W. B. Gilstrap (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. B. Gilstrap all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, con-
taining seventy three and one half acres more or less consisting
of two tracts, one 47 1/2 acres and the other 26 acres, situated
lying and being in Fairview Township, County and State
aforesaid, adjoining lands of Jos. A. McCullough and others
and more particularly described in deed of J. M. Perry to
W. B. Gilstrap, Vol. 11, page 254, reference to which deed is
hereby made, being a part of the 126 acres conveyed by
Elmer J. Gilstrap and others to Jos. A. McCullough on the
17th day of November, 1911, which deed is recorded in Vol. 15,
page 552, and being also a part of the same tract con-
veyed by W. B. Gilstrap to Jos. A. McCullough on the 17th
day of November, 1911 and recorded Vol. 15, page 551,
reference to which is hereby made -
