is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

H. D. Parrish, all that certain piece or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, situated lying and being
on the North side of East Stone Avenue, in the Block East of
Elizabeth Street, and known as lot fifteen as shown by plat made
by J. W. Southern surveyor and recorded in office of C. W. C. for
Greenville County, book 5, v. page 544 and having the following
metes and bounds: Beginning at a point one hundred and nine
feet from East Elizabeth street, and running thence along Stone
Avenue fifty four and one half feet to a stake on Mrs. Peeler
lot, thence along joint lines of lots two, fifteen, and sixteen,
two hundred and six and one half feet to a stake thence
parallel with Stone Avenue fifty-four, and one-half feet to a
