KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E.M. Freeman, of Greenville Co., S.C.

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of (\$4000.) four thousand dollars DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

O.S. Freeman (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

O.S. Freeman, all those five certain pieces, parcels and lots of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, and in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid a short distance beyond the incorporated limits of the City of Greenville, which is fully described in deed conveyed to me by W.H. Irvine, bearing date of Dec. 30, 1912, and recorded in R.M.C. office Dec. 31, 1912 in Volume 20, page 446.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said O.S. Freeman, and to her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said O.S. Freeman, and to her

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
