KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Fannie Glasby, wife of Will Glasby, of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty and no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

H.H. Harris of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

H.H. Harris, his heirs and assigns forever all my right title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County near Berea-Church, near White Horse Road, and being the same tract of land inherited by my aunt Georgia Ann Thompson (known as Sweet Thompson) from her father Gabriel Thompson, the said Georgia Ann Thompson having departed this life intestate in the year A.D. 1913, my said share being a one-third interest of that portion of the estate of said deceased Georgia Ann Thompson which my mother Cornelia Thompson Hunt, now deceased, would have inherited from her sister the said Georgia Ann-Thompson had she survived, and being an equal interest to that which was conveyed by my brother Will Hunt to the said H.H. Harris a few weeks since. The said tract of land contains thirty-six acres, more or less, and was conveyed to the said Georgia Ann Thompson by the Master for Greenville County as I am informed and believe, and reference is hereby made to said deed for description.

I hereby represent that I have in no way mortgaged, sold or pledged my interest herein conveyed to any one in any manner, except as herein conveyed.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said H.H. Harris, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said H.H. Harris, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
