DEED TO E. C. Dickey

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Thomas F. Parker of the City and County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. C. Dickey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E. C. Dickey, All that piece, parcel or lot of land, being known as Lot No. eleven, Block "D" of the Sterling Annex, said Sterling Annex being located just beyond the limits of the City of Greenville, south of Jenkins Street and adjoining the property formerly known as Sterling College. A plat of said Sterling Annex is recorded in Book "D", page No. 9 and transferred to Book "C", page No. 81 by reference to said plat the dimensions of lot No. 11, Block "D" will be found as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Minus Street five hundred fifty (550') feet from the North-west corner of Minus and Valentine Streets and running thence with Minus Street N. 47°-45' East fifty (50') feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44°-50' West One hundred forty-nine & 8/10 (149.8') feet to an iron pin; thence S. 47°-45' West fifty (50') feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44°-50' East one hundred forty-nine & 9/10 (149.9') feet to the point of beginning in Minus Street.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

E. C. Dickey, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said E. C. Dickey, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
