KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. W. Norwood,

in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1,200.00)

DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Herbert W. Provence and Mary Hall Provence (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Herbert W. Provence and Mary Hall Provence and to the survivor of them his or her heirs and assigns. All that lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, fronting on Cleveland Street and containing One acre, (1) More or less, and having the following Metes and bounds according to a Survey by W. A. Adams.

Beginning at an iron pin on fifty foot (50) street on Mrs. Maulis' line; thence with her line S. 85 E. one hundred and seventy eight feet (178) to an iron pin; thence N. 4 E. two hundred and forty eight feet (248) to an iron pin on Cleveland Street; thence with Cleveland Street S. 84 1/2 W. ninety eight feet (98) to a road; thence N. 84 1/2 W. eighty feet (80) to an iron pin on corner of Cleveland Street and fifty foot (50) Street; thence with said fifty foot (50) Street S. 4 W. two hundred and forty three feet to the beginning corner.
