Skinner, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in the Town of Greer, near Franklin Mills, in State and County aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:—Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Mulberry Street and runs thence with J. L. W. McBarter's corner; thence with the said L. H. Littlefield's line fifty feet (50) to Henry Carlton's line; thence with Henry Carlton's line J. F.
