 County, State of South Carolina, about two and one-half miles from the incorpo-  
 rated limits of the City of Greenville, containing 22.29 acres, more or less,  
 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the West  
 side of the Stamton Bridge Road, at the Southeast corner of the lot of land, be-  
 longing to W. A. Chandler, and running thence with said Church lands N. 75 W. 370 feet to an
